Card Techniques:

Pop Out Panel Card Design 2 Fun Fold 57 All Products I used are from Stampin' Up!





Complete Card Supplies: Basic Black Cardstock (cut 4 ¼" x 10 ½") scored at 2 ¼", 2 ½", 5", 5 ½", 8" & 8 ¼" Folded according to the picture above Basic Black Cardstock (cut 2 1/8" x 3") for front of card SCRAP of Basic White Cardstock to die cut cake and small sentiment pc & pc of inside of card Poppy Parade Cardstock (cut 7/16" x 4") Cut 3 for inside of card Sunny Days 12" x 12" DSP (Cut 2" x 4") You need 6 pcs. 3 sets of 2. SCRAP of Sunny Days 12" x 12" DSP for die cutting pc for the front and for the small flower Stamp Sets: Hooray for Surprises Dies: Perennial Postage & Hooray for Surprises Stampin' Inks: Poppy Parade & Crushed Curry Iridescent Pearls Basic Jewels Dimensionals Adhesive of your Choice Stamp N Cut Embossing Machine Directions:

1. Decide where you are going to lay your 2" x 4" pcs of DSP on your card. You need to for the front and 4 for the inside. Pictured images may help with placing.

2. On the 2 DSP pcs that go on the middle panels on the inside of the card, add a Poppy Parade strip to each of those making sure they will fit in the designated area.

3. Adhere the rest of the 2" x 4" pcs of DSP to the card base.

4. Adhere the last Poppy Parade cs pc to the small center panel of the card base.

5. Die cut the SCRAP of DSP with the Perennial Postage rectangle dies. I used the 4th from the smallest. Also cut the small flower from the Hooray for Surprises die set.

6. Cut 2 Basic White pcs from the Perennial Postage Dies. I used the 3rd from the center. Stamp the Birthday sentiment on one with Poppy Parade ink. Stamp 3 candles with Poppy Parade on the other one and the flames in Crushed Curry. Stamp this pc vertical.

7. Stamp the small birthday cake from the Horray for Surprises stamp set on a small scrap of Basic White cs and cut out with the Hooray for Surprises dies.

8. Layer the Perennial Postage DSP die cut onto the small pc of Basic Black cs. Add the Birthday sentiment with dimensionals. Adhere the small birthday cake in the lower left-hand corner of the sentiment pc.

9. Adhere the layered pcs to the middle "spine" pc of the card base that is covered with Poppy Parade cs. Use dimensionals for this.

10. Adhere the pc with the stamped birthday candles to the inside left of the card base.

11. Add small die cut flower to the cake. Add the iridescent pearls to the front of card.

12. Fold card with the front panels tucked behind the layered sentiment pc.
